Legislative Report

For those who voted in the Illinois Primaries, thank you! Now, all of you need to make your plans for voting in the general election on November 5th. Make your voice heard locally, statewide and nationally. **

Currently the State legislature has a number of bills moving through the process that would benefit teachers in general and retired teachers specifically. Details of all these are available on IRTA website (irtaonline.org). There are two bills that would improve conditions for retired teachers to return to classroom employment. There is a bill to eliminate over the road driving tests or seniors. The Governor is "seeking" full funding for pensions plus Trip & Trail insurance programs. He is "pushing" for eliminating the inequities between Tier I and Tier 2 annuitants. What results will be in the legislature is still unknown.
