Legislation

Legislative Update Report compiled from IRTA 3/15/23

About 360 bills passed one or both chambers last week, with just five legislative days remaining on the calendar. Adjournment is still scheduled for May 19 – although that deadline is self-imposed and could be extended.

While budgeteers continue negotiating on the budget, neither chamber has released details – including what revenue number they intend to use.

Add that to dozens of budget requests working their way through the legislature, falling revenue estimates, a very large number of new legislators, and the fact that the past two budget cycles were largely resolved with unprecedented federal funding – and it makes the task of passing a balanced budget by the end of this week even more difficult.

With all of the requests, and difficulties the General Assembly seems to be having with the budget, the TRS board of Trustees certified a \$6.04 billion state government contribution for the System. The contribution is a 2.5% increase over the state's \$5.89 billion contribution for the current fiscal year. Both contributions to TRS and TRIP are set to be fully funded.
